

Guidelines for the Format of Manuscripts Submitted for Publication in “Radio Communication Theory and Technology” and “Special Radio Communication Theory and Technology” Scientific and Technical Journals

1. Manuscript is submitted both in print form (two copies made on A4 sheets are for “Radio Communication Theory and Technology” journal, one copy is for “Special Radio Communication Theory and Technology”) and electronic form (Microsoft Word file). The ideal article length is 5–8 pages.
2. Attached to the manuscript there should be an expert report on the possibility of publishing the article in public media (for publishing only in “Radio Communication Theory and Technology” journal), a review and some information about the authors on a separate paper including **full surname, name, and middle name**, academic degree and title, research interests, official place of work (abbreviations are not allowed), position, phone number and e-mail address.
3. **For post-graduate students the publication of articles is free.**
4. On the first page of the manuscript there should be:
 - USD identifier;
 - title, author’s surname and initials, abstract, and key words (both in **Russian and English** for “Radio Communication Theory and Technology” journal, and only in **Russian** for “Special Radio Communication Theory and Technology”).
5. While typing set the font to Times New Roman, size 12 pt., standard, in one and a half line interval, left indent value is 0,75, full justification. Soft returns should be used. Latin symbols should be set in italics and Russian and Greek symbols – in upright style.
6. Equations should be set in **MathType** equation editor. While setting an equation the following parameters should be used:

The equations referred to in the text should be set on a separate line and have an index number in parenthesis. The equations should be set to full justification, and the index number should be right-aligned.

7. Illustrations should be distinct, hard and anchored to the text; all notes on illustrations should be legible. Any symbols on illustrations made in Microsoft Word or Microsoft Visio should be typed using a font set for Times New Roman, size 9 pt. Each illustration should have a caption typed in 10 pt. font, an illustration number (e.g. Fig. 1) and a brief title.
8. Tables should be typed in 10 pt. font, have a number (e.g. Table 1) and an issue-related title. Tables and illustrations should be preceded by text references to them.
9. Bibliographical references should be numbered in square brackets. Reference list should be made in accordance with the Russian National Standard 7.0.5–2008.
